

Westpark Marlins vs Colony Red Hots

The Westpark Marlins hosted the Colony Red Hots in their first dual meet of the 2010 season on Saturday. Courtney Whyte and Alex King led the way for the Marlins, each setting 2 individual team records in the Girls 13-14 50 breaststroke and Girls 13-14 100 individual medley and the Boys 7-8 freestyle and Boys 7-8 breaststroke respectively.
