

Westpark Marlins vs. Woodbridge WaveRiders 7-11-09

The Westpark Marlins hosted the Woodbridge WaveRiders at the San Marino pool with a robust crowd and celebrated an impressive round of team records. Brothers Alan Su and Eric Su repeatedly broke team records in the Boys 15-18, including many that they had set. In the 50M Butterfly, Alan Su set the team record and both Eric Su and Alan Su broke the 50M Freestyle team record, with Alan beating the record by 66 seconds and Eric swimming the 50M Freestyle with a time of 25:35. Eric Su also broke his individual 2008 record in the 50M Breaststroke and set a team record in the 100IM.

Other team records broken on Saturday include two records by Alexa Clayfield. She swam the Girls 13-14 100IM with a time of 1:08:55, and set a time of 30:99 in the Girls 13-14 50M Backstroke. Rochelle Wong broke her June 2009 record by swimming a time of 33:87 in the Girls 15-18 50M Backstroke. Ryan A. Wong swam the Boys 13-14 50M Breaststroke with a time of 31:69, breaking the Westpark Marlins record set in 2004. Courtney Whyte rounded out the day with a time of 26:94 in the Girls 11-12 50 Freestyle, besting the previous record set in 2007.

Two relay events led to setting new time records. In the Mixed 13-14, 200M Medley Relay, Alexa Clayfield, Rochelle Wong, Gregory Lum, and Skylar Fung swam a time of 2:00:53 and in the Mixed 15-18 200 Medley Relay, Rochelle Wong, Alan Su, Eric Su, and Hannah Goldstick swam 2:01:13 to set a new Marlins team record.

Marlins swimmers who placed first in their events included Matthew Spear in two individual events, Taylor Rogerson, and Brina Jablonski.
