

Westpark Marlins Vs. North Irvine Knights – Irvine World News Meet Report Highlights for July 24, 2010

The Westpark Marlins hosted the North Irvine Knights on Saturday, earning 65 firsts, setting 4 individual records and qualifying 44 swimmers for Champs. Alexa Clayfield broke her own record in the girls 13-14 40 freestyle with a time of 26.21. Courtney Whyte set a record in the girls 13-14 50 breaststroke with her winning time of 34.47. Alexander King broke his own record in the boys 7-8 25 backstroke at 17.92 and Alan Su broke his record, set last year at Champs, in the boys 15-18 breaststroke with a time of 29.88.
