

Westpark Marlins vs. Quail Hill Barracudas 7-25-09

The Westpark Marlins hosted the Quail Hill Barracudas in our last home meet of the 2009 ISL Season. The Marlins continued our successful season by besting 8 previous team records. Marlin swimmers posted 187 time improvements. We also qualified for 98 events at the Championship meet.

Alexa Clayfield set team records in the Girls 13-14 50 Backstroke(30.96) and Butterfly (28.88). Rochelle Wong broke her own record in the Girls 15-18 Backstroke with a time of 33.63. Alan Su broke three team records in the Boys 15-18 50 Free (23.66) and the Boys 15-18 50 Butterfly (26.32) and the Boys 15-18 Breaststroke(30.53). Finally Coach Eric Su broke tied his own team record in the Boys 15-18 100 IM with a time of 1:02.41.

The Marlins swept the Mixed Freestyle Relays with first place finishes for every age group.
