

Westpark Marlins ISL Championships 2010 –Meet Report for August 14, 2010

The Westpark Marlins closed the 2010 ISL season with a fantastic showing at Championships on Saturday. Seventy-seven Marlins competed, earning 73 time improvements, posting 10 individual team records and 2 relay records.

Allyson Whyte set a record in the girls 5-6 25 butterfly with a time of 21.96. Courtney Whyte set 3 records in the girls 13-14 age group; 50 freestyle, 50 breaststroke and the 100 individual medley. Alexa Clayfield broke her own record in the girls 13-14 50 backstroke and Ryan Wong set a team record with a time of 29.58 in the boys 13-14 50 backstroke. Erik Whyte set 3 records in the boys 15-18 age group; 50 backstroke, 50 breaststroke and the 100 individual medley.

The 5-6 mixed freestyle relay team of Allyson Whyte, Nicholas DeLuca, Sophia Venegas and Kendrick Pham came in first with a record setting time of 1:27.28, finishing the season undefeated in their event. The 15-18 mixed 200 medley relay of Erik Whyte, Eric Su, Alan Su and Anh Nguyen set a team record with their time of 1:52.50.

Alexander King took home 3 first place medals in his individual events. The 13-14 Mixed 200 medley relay team of Ryan Wong, Amrik Birk, Alexa Clayfield and Courtney Whyte took second in their race. Rini Jablonski, Katie Rogerson, Duncan Shepherd and Cody Nguyen placed third in the 11-12 mixed 200 freestyle relay. The 7-8 mixed 100 medley of Taylor Rogerson, Eric Zeng, Sophia DeLuca and Matthew Spear placed fourth and the 13-14 mixed 200 freestyle relay of Skylar Fung, Ian Franco, Jillian Cizynski and Amrik Birk placed fourth as well.
